- When the subject is plural, the verb must be plural too.
Trees are our best friends.
- For a collective noun, which is considered a single unit, the verb is usually singular.
A bunch of keys is on the table.
- When the subject consists of two or more nouns joined by and, the verb is plural.
An apple and a banana are fruits.
