## FUN WITH GRAMMAR



A group of words that makes complete sense is called a **sentence**.

A sentence that makes a statement or assertion is called a **statement**. It ends with a full stop.

I can walk with a friend. (statement)

A sentence that asks something is called a **question**. It ends with a question mark.

Who is your friend? (question)

A sentence that expresses a command, a request or an advice is called an **imperative** or a **command** sentence.

Don't make noise. (imperative)
