Question 1. Which rivers originate from the Himalayas?

Answer: The Ganga, Yamuna, and Brahmaputra.

Question 2. Why are the Northern Plains fertile?

Answer: Because Himalayan rivers bring rich, fine soil called silt that is great for growing crops.

Question 3. What is a plateau? Where is it located in India?

Answer: A plateau is a high land with a flat top. In India, it is located in the southern part.

Question 4. Why are there big ports in the coastal region?

Answer: So that large ships can easily load and unload goods by the sea.

Question 5. Why are the Northern Plains densely populated?

Answer: Because the land is flat, the soil is fertile, and plenty of water is available for living and farming.
